EXECUTIVE ENTITIES ACT, 2011

(No. 52 of 2011)

EXECUTIVE ENTITIES REGULATIONS, 2012

The Attorney-General, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 68 of the Executive Entities Act, 2011, makes the following Regulations—

1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Executive Entities Regulations, 2012.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 2nd day of February, 2012.

2. Interpretation.

In these Regulations, the "Act" means the Executive Entities Act, 2011¹.

3. Suspension or revocation of registration of Executive Entity.

Pursuant to section 50(1) of the Act, where the Registrar has reasonable cause to believe that an Executive Entity —

- (a) is no longer being administered to carry out the purposes of the Entity, in accordance with its Charter or Articles;
- (b) fails to comply with any regulatory law;
- (c) fails to satisfy the requirements of section 13(4) of the Act;
- (d) has failed to meet annually in accordance with section 11 of the Act:
- (e) has failed to keep proper accounting records in accordance with section 43 of the Act; or
- (f) has failed to comply with any other requirements under the Act, the Registrar shall serve notice that its registration may be suspended or revoked.

4. Payment of fees.

There shall be charged, collected and paid to the Registrar General in respect of each of the matters set forth in the first column of the *Schedule*, the respective fees set forth opposite thereto in the second column of the *Schedule*.
