BUSINESS LICENCE (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) BILL, 2018

A BILL FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE BUSINESS LICENCE ACT

Enacted by the Parliament of The Bahamas

Short title.

This Act, which amends the Business Licence Act, 2010 (No. 25 of 2010), may be cited as the Business Licence (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 2018.

2. Amendment of section 2 of the principal Act.

Section 2 of the principal Act is amended -

- in the definition of "foreign person" by the deletion of paragraph (i) and the substitution of the following —
 - "(i) a person who is not a citizen of The Bahamas or not a permanent resident with a right to work in The Bahamas;";
- (b) by the repeal of the term and definition of "contract officer", and "regulator".

3. Amendment of section 3 of the principal Act.

Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by —

- (a) the deletion of subsection (3) and the substitution of the following
 - "(3) Every licensee who carries on a business in any year shall
 - (a) on or before the 31st day of January of the succeeding year file and submit to the Secretary as prescribed —
 - (i) an application for renewal of the licence;



- financial results in a manner prescribed by the Secretary showing the turnover of the business for the prior year; and
- (b) pay by the 31st day of March the business licence tax, where applicable, for the succeeding year.";
- (b) the insertion, immediately after subsection (3), of the following "(3A) Subsection (3) shall not apply to a licensee who submitted notification of the inactivation or cessation of the business before the commencement of the succeeding year.".
- Repeal of section 4A of the principal Act.

Section 4A of the principal Act is repealed.

5. Repeal of section 6A of the principal Act.

Section 6A of the principal Act is repealed.

6. Amendment of section 30 of the principal Act.

Subsection (1) of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of paragraph (d) and the substitution of the following —

- "(d) prescribing the form of orders, notices, applications and other documents to be used under this Act;".
- 7. Repeal of sections 33A and 33B of the principal Act.

Sections 33A and 33B of the principal Act are repealed.

8. Amendment of section 36 of the principal Act.

Section 36 of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of subparagraph (aa).

9. Amendment of the First Schedule to the principal Act.

Part I of the First Schedule to the principal Act is amended by the deletion of item (6A).

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend the Business Licence Act, 2010 (No. 25 of 2010) to reflect the state of the law prior to July 1st, 2018.
