**EMERGENCY POWERS ACT (CH. 34)**

**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID 19) (AMENDMENT)(NO. 6)  
REGULATIONS, 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Emergency Powers Act (Ch. 34), the Governor-General makes the following regulations –

**1. Citation.**

These Regulations, which amend the Emergency Powers (Covid 19) Regulations, 2020 (*S.I. No. 21 of 2020*) may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Covid 19)(Amendment)(No. 6) Regulations, 2020.

**2. Amendment of regulation 5A of S.I. No. 21 of 2020.**

Paragraph 1 of regulation 5A of the Emergency Powers (Covid 19) Regulations, 2020 is amended by the deletion of the words “upon summary conviction to the penalty prescribed in regulation 23” and substitution of the words “upon summary conviction to a fine not exceeding twenty thousand dollars or a term of imprisonment not exceeding five years or to both such fine and imprisonment”.
