### EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID 19 PANDEMIC) REGULATIONS, 2020

### EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID 19 PANDEMIC) (BEACHES) ORDER, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Regulations, 2020, I HEREBY make the following Order —

### 1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) (Beaches) Order, 2020.
- (2) This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020.

#### 2. Beaches.

All public beaches shall be open subject to physical distancing protocols and provided that there shall be no greater than five persons in a group.

#### 3. Temporary closure of beaches.

Notwithstanding order 2, all beaches, inclusive of hotel or resort beaches, situate in the islands of —

- (a) Athol Island;
- (b) Grand Bahama;
- (c) New Providence;
- (d) Paradise Island;
- (e) Rose Island; and
- (f) any other cays surrounding New Providence,

shall be closed from 10:00 pm on Thursday, the  $9^{th}$  day of July, 2020 until 5:00 am on Monday the  $13^{th}$  day of July, 2020.

## 4. Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Order, 2020<sup>1</sup>.

For the avoidance of doubt —

(a) nothing in this Order shall conflict with the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Order, 2020;

- (b) the requirement to wear a mask in accordance with order 4 of the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Order,2020 is continued under this Order; and
- (c) the curfew imposed under order 2 of the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Order, 2020 is continued under this Order.
